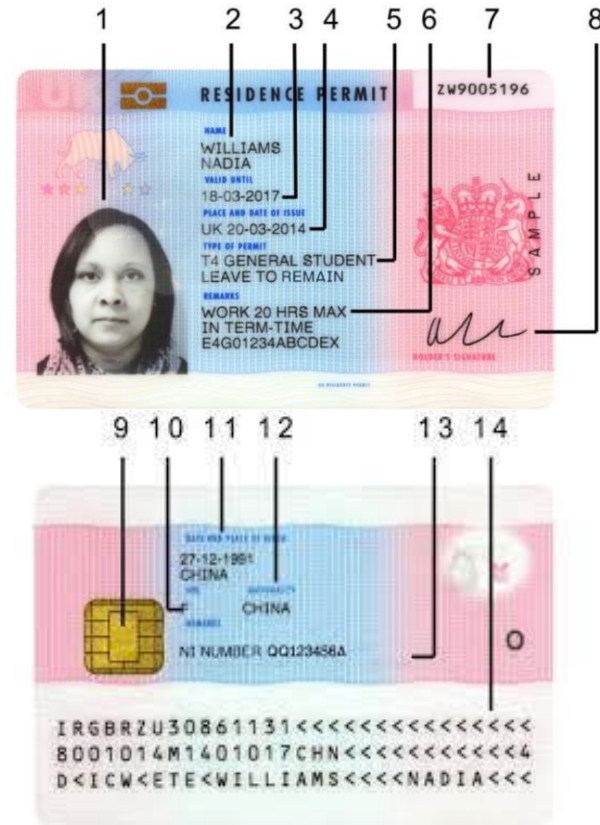

If you have an emergency and you need assistance from the police, fire brigade, coast guard or ambulance service you can call 999.

101 - The Non-Emergency Number for the Police - can also be used to give information about a crime committed, or to contact the police with a general enquiry.

111 – The Non-Emergency Medical Number - Use this for illnesses and minor injuries where life isn't threatened, but you would like some advice on what to do next.
